Shakti Vahini Participation in State AHTU Training

Shri Ravi Kant President Shakti Vahini has been attending various training programmes initiated by different state police for AHTU Training He has attended trainings in Haryana , Delhi , Assam, West Bengal , Sikkim , Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh.

Juvenile Aid Police Unit: JAPU Training, Delhi

The High Court and Juvenile Justice Committee appointed by the Chief Justice have been making a lot of efforts over the last few years to ensure that children are treated with care and support by the law enforcement agencies. Special Juvenile Police Unit (SJPU) training is the outcome of Shakti Vahini's support to this effort.

Shakti Vahini has been appointed as the Nodal NGO by the Special Police Unit for Women and Children, Delhi Police Nanakpura for police station level training of all the police station staff.

Shakti Vahini has been assigned the responsibility to sensitize police officers at the police station level about the various laws related to children and guide the police officers in handling the children with care and affection.

Home Investigation of Victims:

In its order dated August 4, 2011 the Child Welfare Committee, a bench of Magistrate u/s 29(5) of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) Act, 2000 the Chairperson of the Lajpat Nagar Child Welfare Committee directed Shakti Vahini to do Home Investigation of the trafficked victims as per the order of the committee. The state wise details of the Home Investigation done are as follows:

Legal Support to the Victims:

As a part of its anti-trafficking initiative Shakti Vahini has been providing legal support to all the victims rescued by the organization and police together.

Till February, 2012 altogether **81 FIRs** were filed in different police stations in Delhi, Crime Branch Delhi Police and in the states of Assam and West Bengal. Altogether **167 victims** were covered under these 81 FIRs. All these 167 victims are being provided legal aid by Shakti Vahini's legal team.

In addition to this Shakti Vahini is also providing **witnesses, translator, providing transport and accommodation facilities to the victims who are coming to Delhi for court hearing and legal counselling**. We also request the concerned honourable court for passing order for the victims, who are now happily married and living a happy family life so that the victim could give her statement through **video conferencing**.

In a specific case of victims rescued from the Delhi brothel Shakti Vahini moved to the court for the justice of the victims. In this case Shakti Vahini prayed to the court for the rehabilitation of the victims through the Andhra Pradesh government as the Andhra Pradesh government has a detailed rehabilitation mechanism where the state government provides compensation and support to trafficked victims.

PREVENTIVE INITIATIVES:

In Shakti Vahini we have been running **four intervention Centres** in G.B. Road Red Light Area, Faridabad, Gurgaon and Anand Vihar ISBT. These intervention centres have been opened on the basis of the vulnerability of the problem. Besides, we are also running **three intervention points** at Kashmere Gate ISBT, Delhi, Gautam Budh Nagar, Noida, UP and Ghaziabad

Railway Station. Other than these we are also actively working in the New Delhi, Old Delhi and Nizam Uddin Railway stations to prevent the human trafficking as the railway stations are the most prone transit points.

Meeting with the Ground Level Stakeholders: We are conducting at least **one meeting fortnightly in all the intervention centres and points** with the ground level stakeholders like coolies, *safai karmacharies*, TTEs, rickshaw pullers, auto drivers, Taxi drivers, vendors, Pantry car department, RWAs etc.

Besides, we are conducting **quarterly meetings with the primary stakeholders** like police, DLSA, NLSA, district administration, Railway department, Labour Department, Child Welfare Committee, National Commission for Protection of Child Rights, Delhi Commission for Protection of Child Rights and other NGOs.

With the partnership of these NGOs and volunteers we are organizing rural out reach programmes in different villages in Haryana and Uttar Pradesh.

Rehabilitation Initiatives:

Shakti Vahini believes in the government rehabilitation schemes. Regular advocacy with the concerned government department is being done for the implementation of the schemes.

Besides, we do advocacy with the state governments for their intervention in the specific cases. As for example a victim rescued from New Delhi Railway Station was rehabilitated by the Sikkim Government after seven months of Rescue. Shakti Vahini did advocacy with the Sikkim Government via the Resident Commissioner, Sikkim Bhawan in Delhi. The woman is now working as a mother in a school.

There are a sizable number of child labour victims who were compensated by the order of the Child Welfare Committee followed by the advocacy of Shakti Vahini. The compensation amount ranging from Rs.5,000 to Rs.59,000.
